

Aquavits

For life in the water

AQUAVITS are vitamin/mineral tablets specially formulated to supplement the diet of marine mammals, and other large fish-eating animals, including crocodiles, penguins and sharks. Each tablet contains Vitamins A, D₃, B₁, B₁₂, C, pantothenic acid, choline, folic acid, inositol, iron, iodine and biotin.

Fed regularly as part of a properly formulated diet, **AQUAVITS** are intended to replace the vitamins lost during the storage and thawing of fish. This is essential for maintaining general health, disease resistance and to achieve breeding condition.

Care in the use of supplements is needed to avoid direct toxicity or an imbalance of nutrients.

Our recommendations for the dose of **AQUAVITS** are as follows:

Dolphins

3 **AQUAVITS** + 1 x 300mg ferrous gluconate, daily

Pinnipeds

1-3 **AQUAVITS** (depending on size) + 1 x 300mg ferrous gluconate for medium to large animals, daily

Large Penguins and Pelicans

½ **AQUAVIT** daily

Large Crocodilians and Turtles

1 **AQUAVIT** at each feeding

Large Sharks

1 **AQUAVIT** per 20kg bodyweight per week

AQUAVITS are a “dynamic” product, manufactured in small runs to ensure freshness and to allow the formulation of the tablet to be altered rapidly in response to any new requirements.

Most zoos and marinelands in Europe with BEST BREEDING RESULTS for Cetaceans and Pinnipeds use **AQUAVITS**.
